
## Pennsylvania Brings in \$2.35 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of November were \$2.36 billion, which was \$2 million more than the Department of Revenue's Official Estimate.

Collections of \$151 million for corporation taxes came in above the Official Revenue Estimate projection by \$16.6 million. Sales tax collections of \$926 million were lower than expected, coming in \$10 million below the Official Estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$870 million, which was below estimate by \$3 million.

General Fund collections year-to-date total \$12.73 billion. Total Revenue Collections are \$166 million or 1.3% above the official estimate for the fiscal year.
