**SUBJECT:** Questions from the FY2019-20 DEP Budget Hearing

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The following are responses to questions raised at the House Appropriations Committee budget hearing for the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP):

**Chairman Saylor/Rep. Ortity/Rep. Krueger**

➤ **Why is DEP continually getting sued?**

Commonwealth citizens have a great interest in what DEP regulates, as our authority directly affects property, economic interests, quality of life, and health. Everything our agency does occurs under some public interest magnification – and for that reason, we do as much as possible to fully engage the regulated community and the public in all of our actions and activities.

Without exception, over the last 10 years, less than one percent of the Department’s final actions were appealed or challenged in court.

Please also see the response to the next question.

➤ **What percent of permits is challenged?**

Less than one percent of DEP’s final actions are challenged annually.

In 2018, DEP took final (appealable) action on 42,689 applications. There were 128 appeals filed before the Environmental Hearing Board (EHB) in 2018. This constitutes a 0.30 percent appeal rate of our final actions.

Over the last 10 years, the EHB appeal numbers have not varied much – between 117 and 224 appeals per year – though 2008 was a high appeal outlier with 351 appeals filed. The 10-year annual average for appeals is 191.

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Assuming, conservatively, DEP took 30,000 final (appealable) actions each of these years prior (12,000 fewer than 2018), the appeal rate would still be less than one percent (0.64 percent).<sup>1</sup>

The EHB had a particularly busy docket between 1985 and 1992 – when the DEP complement was one-third larger than it is today – where appeals filed per year ranged between 538 and 621.

➤ **How much money has DEP paid in legal fees for the last 10 years?**

Over the past 11 years, the Department has paid a total of \$1.3 million pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law Section 309. This amount is the combination of court awarded fees and some fees paid in settlement, all pursuant to the statutory provision. Please note: The vast majority of these cases where fees were awarded are situations where DEP defended permits issued alongside the permittee and their counsel/experts.

➤ **How much money has DEP paid in reimbursed legal fees to outside groups who successfully challenged the Department in court?**

Please see above. The total amount includes payments to both environmental groups and to other appellants.

- What is the source of the money used to reimburse legal fees?
  - 61% The Clean Water Fund
  - 16% General Operations
  - 14% Air & Energy Title V Management
  - 6% Safe Drinking Water
  - 3% Misc. Funds (mostly Dams & Encroachments/Solid Waste Abatement Fund)

➤ **Does DEP hire outside counsel to handle lawsuits from environmental groups?**

It is extremely rare for DEP to hire outside counsel for an environmental case.<sup>2</sup>

DEP has hired outside counsel for environmental cases in two cases that we are aware of:

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<sup>1</sup> Land development downturn in 2006 is a consideration; however, the concurrent increase in Oil & Gas well permits and Chapter 102/105 permits in that program and the growth of the MS4 program more than made up for final action numbers from the decreased land development activity. Thus the 30,000 assumption is likely low.

<sup>2</sup> Note: The Department does use outside counsel in some non-environmental cases. For example, personnel cases, some civil rights cases where Office of Attorney General does not accept referral, and in very unique toxic tort cases where private counsel is appropriate (MTBE case). DEP does more of its own litigation and defense than most other agencies, as we are equipped to do so.

Robinson Township RE: the environmental rights amendment. This decision was made under a prior administration, so we are not able to answer the reasons for this decision; however, the case did represent an important, unique, and significant constitutional issue.

EQT – Declaratory Judgement (PA Supreme Court argument only) RE: The Clean Streams Law civil penalty provision. This is the only case under the Wolf Administration and under DEP’s current Chief Counsel where outside counsel has been engaged. There were a number of legal and strategic reasons for hiring specialized statutory construction counsel in this case. Moreover, EQT, which has experienced in-house environmental counsel and regular outside environmental counsel, also chose to hire an appellate specialist in this case, perhaps for similar strategic reasons. This outside counsel engagement in EQT was for the Supreme Court argument only. The DEP Office of Chief Counsel litigated the case in the lower court and prevailed in the civil penalty case and that appeal.

Again, it is remarkably rare to encounter a case that DEP counsel cannot handle, as we have some of the most experienced state environmental compliance and enforcement attorneys in both the Commonwealth and the United States.

➤ **Does DEP have adequate staff to handle lawsuits from outside groups?**

While DEP is down 25 attorney positions from 14 years ago and faces competition for hiring from the private sector and budgetary pressures, we have worked to be more efficient and our attorneys are highly competent to handle lawsuits.

➤ **In the last 10 years, how much money and staff time have been spent on lawsuits with oil & gas companies?**

Unfortunately, there is likely no way to meaningfully answer this question as we do not track our work in this way. We have a central office program and three regional offices that house oil and gas program technical staff. We also have approximately 10 attorneys statewide that do some or all oil and gas program legal work.

➤ **When and why does DEP hire outside counsel?**

It is particularly rare in environmental cases, and these decisions have been made in the past by different people, but we can try to answer this question with respect to the current administration. On any particular case, the decision is fact and circumstance specific and typically involves litigation strategy.

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DEP retains outside counsel in environmental litigation only in extraordinary situations because we already employ a number of highly specialized litigators and environmental law specialists whose primary function is to represent the Department in court. Moreover, it is cost prohibitive to hire outside counsel in the thousands of compliance and enforcement actions we are engaged in each year.<sup>3</sup>

Of the two environmental cases where DEP has used outside counsel in the past 10 years, this is what was spent:

Total= \$933,235.50

Case: Robinson Township Article 1, section 27 litigation.

Corbett Administration:

Amount paid: \$765,376.75

Paid over years: 2012-2014

Unique and constitutional case.

Case: EQT Supreme Court Appeal (only)

Wolf Administration:

Amount paid: \$167,858.75

Paid during year: 2017

PA Supreme Court brief and argument. Key civil penalty provision in the Clean Streams Law being challenged.

### **Rep. Ortity**

- What is the cost-benefit analysis for the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards (AEPS) changes to increase renewables in the draft Climate Action Plan?

The draft Pennsylvania Climate Action Plan (CAP) is available on the DEP website at the following URL:

There are several sections that may be helpful in better understanding the incorporation of more renewables:

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<sup>3</sup> The litigation statistics provided related to appeals per year reflect only those actions that are appealed. Thousands more compliance and enforcement actions are taken each year which require compliance and legal staff time.

1. There is a cost-benefit analysis for the strategy “Create a diverse portfolio of clean, utility-scale electricity generation” beginning on page 68 of the draft CAP. Included in that strategy are several possible actions, one of which is increasing AEPS Tier 1 targets. That section includes cost-benefit, but it is for the entire strategy, not just the AEPS portion.
2. In Appendix A there is more detailed information by each action. Table 11 on page A-1 shows Greenhouse Gas (GHG) reductions, cost per GHG reduction, and net present value for each action (including AEPS).
3. Also in the Appendix on page A-18 is a breakdown of cost-benefit analysis for just the AEPS strategy.

**Rep. Fiedler**

- What was the highest complement number DEP had in the last 15 years? What is it currently?

DEP had 3,124 authorized positions with 2,874 filled positions on December 31, 2005. The current year authorized is 2,497 with 2,308 filled as of December 31, 2018.

**Rep. Bullock**

- Total number and list of Environmental Justice areas.

There are currently 1,015 Environmental Justice (EJ) Areas. DEP identifies EJ Areas at the census tract level, and an EJ Area is any census tract where 20 percent or more individuals live in poverty and/or 30 percent or more of the population is minority based on the most current census tract data from the U.S. Census Bureau and the federal guidelines for poverty.

Please find attached a list of EJ Areas in the Commonwealth.

**Rep. Fred Keller**

- For SRBC and DRBC, how are dues calculated and what are the dues that each state pays?

Please find attached the DRBC Contribution History and the SRBC FY2020 Budget, which show the dues allocations and the dues paid by each state for DRBC and SRBC respectively. Both are a split of the annual projected budgets. DRBC is set by a formula in the compact but has been renegotiated over the years; the current splits are in the attached summary of costs by year.

SRBC is set as an agreement between the states by resolution (it is referenced in the sheet attached (Resolution 96-08); it is not specified in the compact.

- Does SRBC have performance measures?

SRBC does work for DEP that is on a contracted basis and for this work, SRBC has deliverables and due dates. However, these are not performance measures exactly, rather terms of a contract. For other activities, SRBC does not have performance standards that they must meet as required by Pennsylvania.

- Does SRBC have performance measures related to the Chesapeake Bay?

Because SRBC is not one of the signatories to the Chesapeake Bay agreement, the commission does not have performance measures related to the Chesapeake Bay agreement.

- Are there performance measures for the Chesapeake Bay?

Pennsylvania is a signatory to the 2014 Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement, which contains 10 goals and 31 outcomes related to the diversity, environmental literacy, stewardship, water quality, and habitat improvement in the Chesapeake Bay. The Chesapeake Bay Program partnership has developed management strategies and two-year workplans that specify actions to achieve the outcomes.

Included in these outcomes is the achievement of the nutrient and sediment reduction targets established as part of the 2010 Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL). Pennsylvania is currently developing the third version of a Watershed Implementation Plan to address revised reduction targets established by the Chesapeake Bay Program partnership in July 2018. By 2025, Pennsylvania is obligated to reduce nitrogen pollution levels by 34.18 million pounds per year and phosphorous levels by 700,000 pounds per year.

**Rep. Fred Keller/Chairman Saylor**

- In August 2018, a New York plant released 35 million gallons of untreated waste into the Susquehanna River. Was it assessed a fine? If so, how much was it?

There was a release related to a flooding event in August of 2018 that impacted the City of Binghamton, New York, and its related sewage treatment plant, which discharges to the Susquehanna River. As the facility is located in New York State, DEP does not have jurisdiction over the facility and did not assess a penalty on the facility. The sewage discharge in question appears to be part of a combined sewer overflow (CSO) event that occurred on August 13, 2018,

and lasted over approximately six days. This was one of approximately 20 CSO discharges reported for this facility in August. We would not expect the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) to assess a penalty as CSOs are authorized outfalls under the facility's NPDES permit designed to discharge to alleviate excessive flows and prevent infrastructure, homeowner, or facility damage. We have contacted NYSDEC but have not gotten a response. We will be sure to follow up when we receive a response.

**Rep. Chris Quinn**

- Between DEP and the Conservation Districts, how many inspectors are there for the pipeline work?

Between DEP and the Conservation Districts, we estimate a total of 220 staff devote all or a portion of their time inspecting pipeline construction. This figure is broken down into the following:

- **Conservation district staff** provide Ch. 102 and Ch. 105 program support actions including the inspection of active construction sites. This construction includes either distribution or transmission pipelines (but not gathering lines, which are inspected by DEP's Oil & Gas program). Roughly 128 conservation district technicians provided this work in 66 counties. These staff do not dedicate their entire workday to performing pipeline inspection work but inspections on pipeline activities (relating to distribution and transmission lines) is one element of their work duties depending on the amount of active pipeline construction work in their respective county.
- **Regional DEP staff** perform actions to carry out the Ch. 102 and Ch. 105 programs as well. Between 40 and 50 DEP regional staff are involved in performing these pipeline inspections. Again, these staff are not solely working on pipeline inspections, but an element of their work duties involves inspecting construction sites, including pipelines (distribution and transmission lines) to ensure regulatory and permit compliance.
- **The Office of Oil and Gas Management (O&G)** has District Office staff that perform various functions, including the inspection of oil and gas pipelines. These O&G staff work, in part, overseeing work relating to the construction of the gathering lines and do not oversee either distribution or transmission line construction. The O&G program has a total of 43 staff working under this program in the O&G District Offices that perform inspections on the gathering lines as part of their overall program duties.

**Rep. White**

- What is the data on discharges from the Willow Grove base?

Please find attached the discharge sampling information (HAGS Sampling Data).

- How many families have been impacted by the Willow Grove base PFAS situation?

Following sampling of nearly 900 wells, the projected impacts are 172 homes about the Health Advisory Limit (HAL) of 70 ppt, and 126 below the HAL but above 40 pt. All homes are being connected to the public water system.

From the public water systems, the populations impacted prior to the wells being taken offline were as follows:

- Warminster Municipal Authority – 40,000
- Horsham Water and Sewer Authority – 25,000
- Warring Township Water and Sewer Department – 21,588
- Horsham Air Guard Station – 440.

**Rep. Gabler**

- Has DEP been in communication with NYU School of Law's State Energy & Environmental Impact Center? Has there been any agreement to participate?

Attorneys from the DEP Office of Chief Counsel participate in conference calls with other states' attorneys to discuss how certain federal environmental actions may impact the states participating in the calls. From time to time, fellows from the NYU School of Law's State Energy & Environmental Impact Center participate on the calls. The fellows' involvement is limited to providing an update on certain federal environmental activities. Once they have completed the update, the fellows drop off the calls, and the states' attorneys deliberate among themselves. DEP Office of Chief Counsel has never been in direct contact with the fellows or the university for one-on-one discussions of any kind, and DEP is not a party to any agreement that involves the NYU center.



**Rep. McCarter**

- How many inspectors and air quality monitors does DEP have monitoring methane?

*Air Quality Field Operation Inspection Staff (inspection staff cover all air pollutant sources, not just methane)*

\*SERO and SCRO - No significant shale natural gas drilling, compression and processing activities at these regions.

During inspections all DEP staff look for methane leaks using audible, visual, and olfactory observations. The Air Quality Inspectors also use six (6) forward looking infrared (FLIR) cameras to detect leaks. These same inspectors check for the facilities’ compliance with leak detection and repair (LDAR) requirements found in AQ Permit Exemption 38 and General Permit 5 (applicable to Mid-stream gas gathering and processing) and General Permit 5A for Well sites. These authorizations also require facilities to regularly inspect components for leaks and fix them expeditiously as practicable. The regional field staff also review the Compliance Demonstration Reports, Compliance Certifications, including LDAR inspection results, required by the authorizations.

DEP does not directly measure methane in the air through ambient monitoring stations. DEP used a continuous methane analyzer system during its unconventional gas sector long term monitoring project, but the data gathered using the system was unreliable. DEP continues to evaluate new technological advances in this area.

**Rep. Comitta**

- I want to thank Governor Wolf and you for taking the actions you have to address climate change so far, because I think not acting on this critical issue will have severe consequences on our economy, the environment and our children's future.

As part of those efforts, I understand DEP will shortly be issuing its latest update to Pennsylvania' Climate Action Plan. If the draft is any indication of the scope of what you intend to recommend, we have a big job ahead of us.

The draft recommended things like dramatically expanding the renewables goals in the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards, expanding the Act 129 Energy Use Reduction Program for electric utilities and including natural gas for the first time, providing incentives for electric vehicle use and more.

No one wants to see these recommendations get dusty on a shelf. What next steps do you plan to take to help develop a consensus around how to implement the most important of the Plan's recommendations?

In addition to contributing fully to responding to the Governor's 2019-1 Executive Order to Lead by Example: *Commonwealth Leadership in Addressing Climate Change and Promoting Energy Conservation and Sustainable Governance*, DEP will be providing advice and assistance to the GreenGov Council on conservation, sustainability and efficiency strategies.

With respect to next steps for the implementation of the Climate Action Plan, DEP intends to help Pennsylvanians, local governments, companies, non-profits and other interested parties to assess how they can contribute towards the climate goal by choosing to implement the best fit actions described in the report. Most importantly the Climate Action Plan will be the baseline information used to motivate and enable Pennsylvanians to assess actions. We will look to help Pennsylvanians evaluate and possibly further develop information such as "what are the opportunities for largest energy and cost savings across and within sectors for me, or my operations?" "How can I utilize goal setting and comprehensive planning to identify sectors with the largest opportunities to meet climate goals including near-term and long-term implementation strategies?"

Our key focus of assistance will be:

- Identifying infrastructure for resiliency planning
  - 1) Estimating potential impact of planning for community segments
- Energy Efficiency/Buildings
  - 1) Tracking energy use
  - 2) Assessing EE potential
- Transportation
  - 1) Estimating impacts of various levels of alt. fuel vehicle adoption, including electrification
  - 2) Expanding and incentivizing use of public transit
- Energy Supply
  - 1) Identifying how much local, cost-effective renewable energy generation will/can be available at different geographic scales

- I want to thank you for the action you took last week to stop the review of permits for the Mariner East II and other Energy Transfer/Sunoco pipeline projects until they come into compliance with orders you have issued them.

At the same time, Governor Wolf has called on the General Assembly to fill gaps in the way the state regulates pipelines, including their routes.

While I think even stronger action is needed, what specific legislative initiatives are you supporting or legislative proposals would you support to deal with the very real pipeline safety and routing issues we are all very concerned about?

We support legislation to provide the Public Utility Commission with the authority to regulate siting and routing of intrastate pipelines; legislation requiring pipeline operators to provide more information to schools located within 1,000 feet of a pipeline, including how to respond to leaks; legislation requiring public utility facilities transporting natural gas or natural gas liquids to work with county emergency coordinators on response to releases and emergency response; and legislation mandating the installation and use of automatic or remote shutoff valves in high consequence areas.

- Last summer my district and areas all across the state experienced heavy rains that caused flooding from streams at levels many have never seen in the past. There are ways of helping to reduce flood damage and pollution from storm water like installing green infrastructure and retrofitting existing storm water facilities, but what my communities lack is state help paying for these projects. What new funding is included in the budget to help communities deal with the damage and the water pollution caused by storm water and flooding?

There is \$14.974 million in the FY2019-20 budget for PENNVEST related to storm water, water and sewer grants. Governor Wolf's proposed Restore Pennsylvania initiative, while separate from the budget, would provide much-needed funding to assist with storm water and flooding remediation.

- DEP has been cited by US EPA for "severe understaffing" of a number of its programs that protect Pennsylvanians' health for several years running, including the current fiscal year, yet DEP's authorized complement in the Governor's proposed budget is unchanged - it remains at 2,509. For comparison, the total staff complement in the department was 3,079 in 2008. How can the agency possibly meet the minimum requirements of its mission with this continued severe understaffing?

Following years of budget cuts and concomitant staffing reductions, DEP has received letters from the Federal Government regarding staff and inspection levels on several programs in recent years, including letters from EPA about DEP's bureaus of Air Quality and Safe Drinking Water (the latter being addressed in the next question), and from the US Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE).

#### *Air Quality*

DEP maintains a network of 70 ambient air quality monitoring stations across the Commonwealth. In June of 2018, EPA conducted a Technical Systems Audit of DEP's ambient air monitoring program and found "BAQ's [Bureau of Air Quality's] air monitoring network is severely understaffed." At the time of the EPA audit, there were 25 ambient air monitoring program staff with seven vacancies (these are not inspectors and counted above). DEP authorized five (5) addition ambient air monitoring positions for FY 18/19. Two (2) of those positions have been filled with the remaining three (3) in the process of being filled. DEP believes that 30 positions is sufficient to operate the existing ambient air monitoring network.

#### *OSMRE*

OSMRE cited DEP for not meeting our inspection frequencies. We entered into a two-year action plan with OSMRE and received a letter in September 2018 acknowledging that DEP now meets inspection frequencies, increasing overall compliance with required inspection frequencies from 66.72 percent in 2014 to 92.45 percent in 2018. Part of the solution was staffing - DEP worked to fill vacancies - and part of it involved leveraging technology, specifically the implementation of an aerial inspection program.

DEP is using the resources at its disposal and leveraging technology to ensure that it continues to realize its mission to protect the environment and public health and safety. Investments in information technology modernization - especially through the ePermitting and eInspections initiatives, along with digitization efforts - have allowed the Department to increase efficiency and responsiveness. Furthermore, the dedication and professionalism of DEP's staff remains central to our continued ability to meet the demands of our important mission.

- The operating budget for the Safe Drinking Water Program, which has been continually cited by US EPA for severe understaffing, including the current fiscal year, is flat-lined in the Governor's proposed budget. No new positions are called for. How can DEP assure our citizens that the Commonwealth is protecting their drinking water?

DEP received a letter from EPA in 2016 citing concerns about understaffing and sanitarian workload. Since that time, the Department developed and is implementing a plan to address the concerns, including a rulemaking to update fees to address the funding gap and an interim plan to hire additional sanitarians. We continue to provide EPA with regular updates on our progress.

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As a result of the Final General Update (to Chapter 109) and Fees Rulemaking (published on August 18, 2018), DEP amended the existing permit fees and added a new annual fee to supplement Commonwealth costs and fill a \$7.5 million funding gap. Ahead of the final rulemaking, DEP received approval to hire 33 new staff to restore staffing levels. The 33 positions include: 17 sanitarians (field inspectors), 5 engineers, 2 geologists, 4 filter plant/compliance specialists, and 5 other positions to fill in gaps. DEP also received approval to use waived funds to begin the hiring process in 2018. Nearly all of the positions have been filled. Beginning in 2019, these positions are being funded through the new fees (being deposited into the Safe Drinking Water Fund).

Regarding how DEP is assuring our citizens that drinking water is being protected, 28 of the 33 positions (85 percent) are field positions to ensure sufficient staffing levels to properly administer the Safe Drinking Water Act and regulations. DEP Central Office staff have been diligently and expeditiously developing and delivering training to the new staff to get them trained as soon as possible. The new staff are also working their way through the Safe Drinking Water training plan to ensure completion of additional on-line, classroom, and on-the-job training.
