1. House Bill 57	Payne		House Bill 57 amends the interest rate associated with recovery of purchased gas costs; eliminates migration rider; and provides for recovery of costs incurred to implement customer choice.
2. House Bill 140	Killion		House Bill 140 amends Act 279 of 1982 (providing for ridesharing arrangements) to permit a carpool or vanpool operated by a private operator to be considered a ridesharing arrangement.
3. House Bill 164	Stephens		House Bill 164 amends the Crimes Code regarding animal fighting paraphernalia.
4. House Bill 188	Sonney		House Bill 188 amends the Agricultural Area Security Law to provide for wind power generation systems on preserved farmland.
5. House Bill 315	Ellis		House Bill 315 allows minors ages 12 and 13 to be employed as youth sports officials.
6. House Bill 319	Knowles		House Bill 319 provides for the procurement of written testimony/audio recordings by parties of an Unemployment Compensation appeals hearing.
7. House Bill 530	Reese		House Bill 530 amends the Public School Code to establish a permanent school district deduction for food services expenditures and a 2-year school district deduction for amounts paid to cyber charter schools in the formula for determining a school district's per student cyber charter school payment; also amends the Public School Code to extensively revise and add charter school provisions.
8. House Bill 568	Evankovich		House Bill 568 amends the PA Construction Code Act regarding the issuance of certificates of occupancy to "uncertified" commercial buildings.
