1. House Bill 34	Grell		House Bill 34 repeals Subchapter A of Chapter 73 of the Judicial Code (PA Uniform Arbitration Act) and replaces it with Subsection A.1, (Revised Uniform Arbitration Act).
2. House Bill 272	Neuman		House Bill 272 amends the Sexual Assault Testing and Evidence Collection Act to include mandatory timeframes and technical requirements for the submission and reporting of sexual assault evidence, and to provide for victims' rights.
3. House Bill 341	Gingrich		House Bill 341 amends the Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law by requiring property disclosure statements to provide notification of sinkholes, the location and condition of defined storm water facilities, and whether the purchaser is responsible for ongoing maintenance of the storm water facilities.
4. House Bill 423	Simmons		House Bill 423 amends the Public School Code to provide civil immunity to school bus drivers administering epinephrine auto-injectors.
5. House Bill 447	Saylor		House Bill 447 amends the Landlord and Tenant Act by adding provisions for early termination of a lease if a tenant dies.
6. House Bill 753	Culver		House Bill 753 establishes the PA Long-Term Care Council within the Department of Aging; and repeals a related provision in the Public Welfare Code.
7. House Bill 762	Roae		House Bill 762 authorizes and requires the Secretary of Education to enter into an interstate reciprocity agreement governing the provision of distance education by institutions of higher education.
