1. House Bill 11	Grove		House Bill 11 establishes the Lean Government Practices Program and confers powers and duties on the Governor's Office of Transformation.
2. House Bill 74	Kauffman		House Bill 74 amends the Crimes Code regarding grading for endangering the welfare of children.
3. House Bill 122	Delozier		House Bill 122 amends the Uniform Transfers to Minors Act (UTMA) in order to increase the dollar limit of a transfer that may be made from the custodial account of a minor without court approval; and allows a judge to order that assets of a minor acquired through inheritance be placed in a "529 account."
4. House Bill 124	Delozier		House Bill 124 amends the Protection From Abuse Act in order to provide the court with information regarding whether the defendant has been involved with a child abuse investigation.
5. House Bill 410	Hackett		House Bill 410 amends the Domestic Relations Code (Title 23) Chapter 53 (relating to child custody) to provide for custody matters and support matters when the child is conceived as a result of certain sexual offenses.
6. House Bill 424	Simmons		House Bill 424 amends the Crimes Code to increase the penalty for concealing the death of a child.
7. House Bill 972	Pickett		House Bill 972 amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 to provide for electronic delivery of insurance policies and annuities.
