1. House Bill 189	Sonney		House Bill 189 amends the Liquor Code (Title 47) to allow for the direct shipment of wine to residents of the Commonwealth; establishes new privileges for licensees; and permits a new entity to obtain a special occasion permit.
2. House Bill 389	Oberlander		House Bill 389 adds Chief Nursing Officer to the administrative structure of the PA Department of Health.
3. House Bill 475	Adolph		House Bill 475 designates a portion of State Route 22/322 in Juniata County as the Honorable Daniel F. Clark Memorial Highway.
4. House Bill 499	Emrick		House Bill 499 amends the Public School Code to require a teacher preparation program to recommend applicants for certification who meet certain grade point average standards, and to prohibit a teacher preparation program from requiring a student to obtain a passing score on assessments required for teacher certification as a condition of graduation, or including a student's scores from these assessments as a component of a student's grade in any course.

6. House Bill 752	Christiana		House Bill 752 amends the Tax Reform Code to increase the amount of available tax credits in the Education Improvement Tax Credit program and the Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit program.
7. House Bill 1039	O'Neill		House Bill 1039 amends the Public School Code to allow a person who does not hold a teaching certificate to teach as a substitute for limited time periods if the person meets certain requirements.
8. Senate Bill 266	Eichelberger		Senate Bill 266 authorizes the conveyance of two permanent utility and access easements in Peters Township, Franklin County.
