1. House Bill 64	Adolph		House Bill 64 requires licensed psychologists, social workers, marriage and family therapists and professional counselors to complete at least one hour of continuing education in suicide prevention.
2. House Bill 325	Keller, M.		House Bill 325 amends the Auctioneer Licensing and Trading Assistant Registration Act to update the Act and eliminate the Auction House license.
3. House Bill 339	Barrar		House Bill 339 amends Act 284 of 1921, known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, by requiring reimbursement for emergency medical services provided when no transport of a patient is initiated.
4. House Bill 347	O'Neill		House Bill 347 amends Title 35 (Health and Safety) by adding a section requiring insurers to pay EMS claims directly to an EMS agency for 911 calls.
5. House Bill 582	Causer		House Bill 582 increases the annual income limit for retired persons to qualify for vehicle registration fee exemption from \$19,200 to \$23,500.
6. House Bill 662	Pashinski		House Bill 662 establishes the Kinship Caregiver Navigator Pilot Program within the Department of Human Services (DHS).
7. House Bill 898	Boyle, K.		House Bill 898 designates Philadelphia Prison System prisoner transport units and emergency response vehicles operated by the PA Turnpike as emergency vehicles, permitting them to utilize flashing lights and sirens.
