2. House Bill 1452	Gillespie		House Bill 1452 amends Title 34 (Game and Wildlife Code) to provide for a discounted hunting license for volunteer Hunter Trapper Education (HTE) instructors.
3. House Bill 1722	Jozwiak		House Bill 1722 amends Title 34 (Game and Wildlife Code) to provide for the use of leashed blood-tracking dogs to recover white-tailed deer and black bear.
4. House Bill 1797	Keller, M		House Bill 1797 amends Title 75 to provide for autocycles.
5. House Bill 1801	Irvin		House Bill 1801 appropriates funding for the State Correctional Institutions appropriation within the Department of Corrections. It would take effect immediately and shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2015.
6. House Bill 1802	Toepel		House Bill 1802 makes an appropriation from the General Fund to the Executive Offices for the purpose of child advocacy centers for the fiscal year July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016. The act shall take effect immediately and shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2015.
7. House Bill 1803	Mackenzie		House Bill 1803 appropriates funding from the General Fund to the Department of Human Services (DHS) for hospital-based burn centers for the fiscal year July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016.
8. Senate Bill 479	Gordner		Senate Bill 479 designates the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources' Resource Management Center in Columbia County as the Edward W. Helfrick Resource Management Center.
