1. House Bill 564	Pickett		House Bill 564 designating celestite, more commonly known as Celestine, as the official State mineral.
2. House Bill 932	Driscoll		House Bill 932 amends the Tax Reform Code to provide for a new exemption from the realty transfer tax.
3. House Bill 1473	Boback		House Bill 1473 amends Title 51 by adding a chapter that will exempt a portion of a veterans' benefit from income requirements for Commonwealth programs.
4. House Bill 1516	Farry		House Bill 1516 amends the Crimes Code to provide that leaving a cat or dog in a vehicle under certain conditions is a summary offense, and to provide for immunity for certain individuals who rescue an animal from an unattended vehicle.
5. House Bill 1525	Petri		House Bill 1525 expedites the procedures for the relinquishment or termination of parental rights in the course of the legal process to adopt a child in PA.
6. House Bill 2293	Cutler		House Bill 2293 designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 741 in Lancaster County as the Corporal Eric M. Torbert, Jr., Memorial Bridge.
7. House Bill 2304	Sainato		House Bill 2304 amends Titles 51 and 75 by changing the name of the "Pennsylvania Veterans' Memorial Trust Fund" and enhancing the Fund to better preserve monuments and memorials dedicated to Pennsylvania's veterans and military personnel.
8. Senate Bill 889	Baker		Senate Bill 889 includes enforcement officers and investigators of both the PA Game Commission (PGC) and the PA Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC) under the Enforcement Officer Disability Benefits Law, also known as the Heart and Lung Act.
